

## **ELECTRONIC SECURED ADJUDICATION FORMS ENVIRONMENT**

Eligible citizens of visa exempt countries can apply online using Form I-192 and Form I-212 through e-SAFE. However, applicants who complete electronic filing via e-SAFE will need to go to the following ports of entry to complete the biometrics appointment portion (fingerprints and photograph) of the waiver process:
